



# Reception Newsletter 9th November 2023

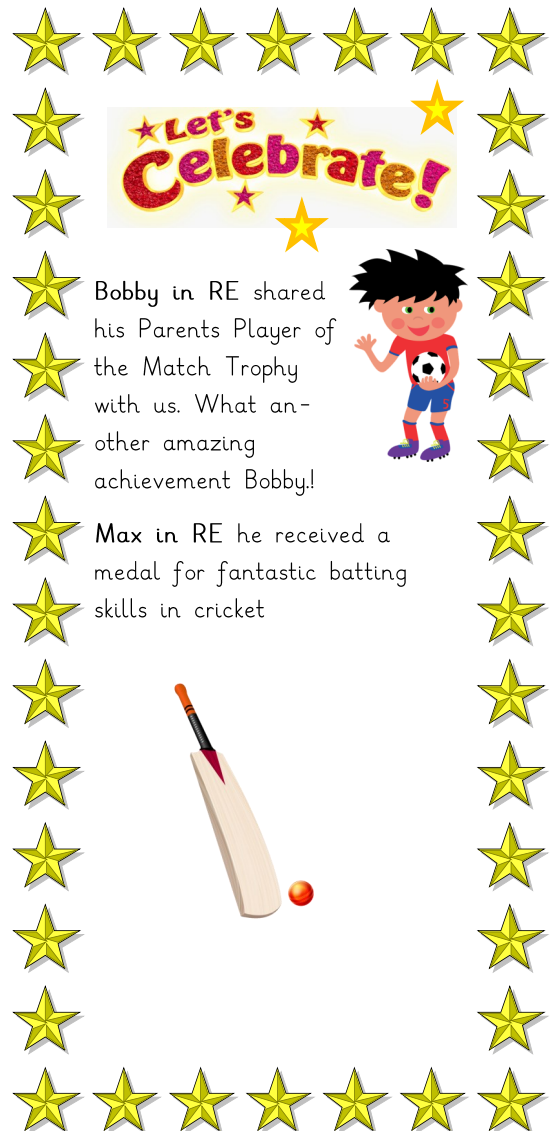
