EYFS Objectives

Completing this activity with your child helps them reach these age related expectations:

Mathematics:

To talk and identify the patterns around them - stripes, spotty, etc.

Expressive arts and design:

To explore different materials and develop their ideas of what to make.

To develop their own ideas.

To join different materials and explore different textures.



This week on 'Odd Sock' day we have looked at different patterns on socks. We sorted and matched the socks according to their pattern. We talked about the patterns that we saw - stripy, spotty, wavy, etc.. For their homework could your child look for any of these patterns at home - what patterns can they see on their socks or their other family members' socks? Do you have any spotty ones? Can they name the patterns?

In our story Odd Socks the stripy sock was turned into a sock puppet. Could you find an old sock and talk about the type of sock puppet that they want to make? Talk about the materials that they need to use to make their creations.

Please bring their sock puppets into Pre-School so they show everyone their creations.
