I love books that are in a series so I can follow the same character.

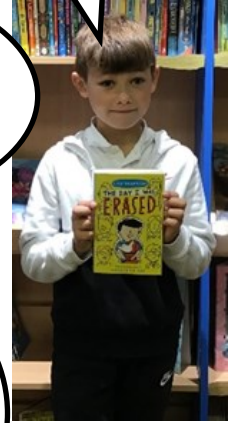


My brother got me into Harry Potter books. Harry is my favourite character because his personality is so funny.
