

ATTENDANCE IN 4H

Attendance is important in every year but especially important in Year 4!

It is vital that you are in school and on time every day so that you can learn as much as you can over the school year; some new learning in Year 4 can be a bit tricky, so you need lots of regular opportunities to practise your new skills!

Let's try really hard to get GOLD this year.

This time last year (Autumn 1), we came 6th out of 14 classes with an attendance of 97.06%.

Let's try and get an even higher place on the leader board for this year!

I know we can rise to the challenge, even though some people may have to follow isolation rules – but don't worry, because if you are isolating the register code doesn't affect your attendance figure (because you are doing what the Government have told you to do!)

This half term last year we had 21 children who had attendance of above 96%, which at Sherdley we consider GOOD.

However we also had 3 children who had attendance below 90%, which we'd really like to improve.

So let's see what we can achieve this half term!

To improve your attendance and reach 'Silver' and then 'Gold' it is simple.....be in school on time!

Your percentage attendance increases every day that you come into school; so if you are not yet at Gold you can achieve it by the end of the year if you come into school whenever you are able to.
