**Polar**- cold places at the top and bottom of the Earth.

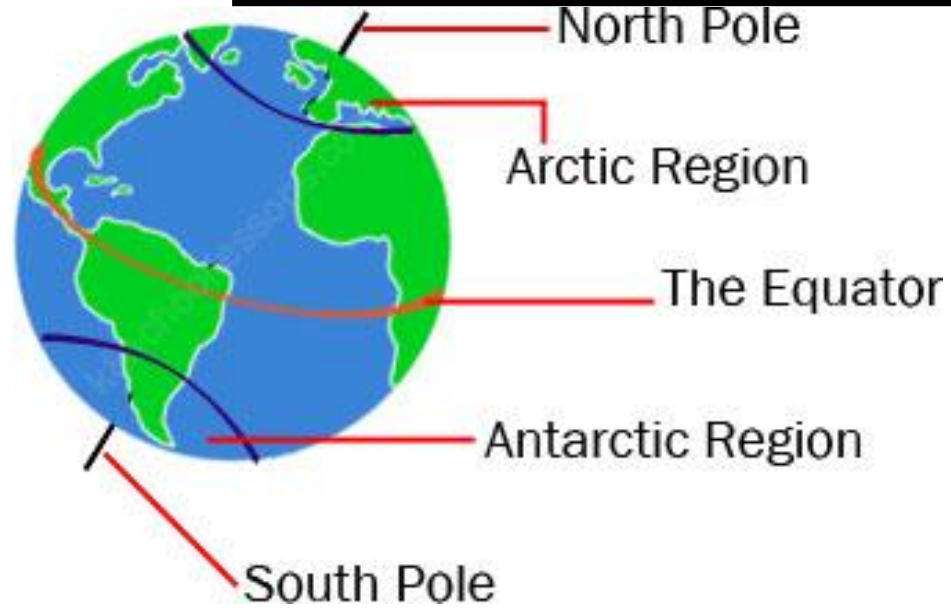
**Rainforest**- thick forest with lots of rain
